Developing strategies and preparing proposals for funding, sponsorship and other resourcing options. Participants will work through developing the basics of a grant or sponsorship application for funding or other resources and identify and target potential sources of support. **Money and help - how to get it, how to keep it...** This course will show you how to identify sources of assistance and how to secure it. It illustrates how groups can receive support beyond cash. It also sets out ways of preparing strong funding submissions.

Network within Communities CVNWC01A

Concentrates on how to establish and maintain successful networks within and across communities. Participants will learn key concepts and undertake practical exercises dealing with the nature of networks, identifying network opportunities and effective networking tools to suit their organisation. **Making the most of what your community has...** This course will give you a way to identify local resources and to tap into them.
